

REINSTATEMENT OF MEMBERSHIP

Reinstatement of membership is deemed necessary when a member for more than two (2) consecutive years have not submitted application for the renewal of membership or have not paid the fees associated with the application and have thus been removed from the register. In accordance with section 28 of the act and regulations section 32, council can approve restoration to the register of membership.

The following procedures should be adhered to for the Reinstatement of Membership to The Bahamas Institute of Chartered Accountants.

- The Council must approve an application made by a member for reinstatement
- Where the council rejects the application of any person, it shall within ten days from the date of such rejection give written notice thereof to the person whose application was so rejected.
